Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Enhancement Plan Update

Torrey Pines Association and Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Foundation invite you to participate in the fifth of a series of public workshops designed to solicit input and support as we update the 1985 Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Enhancement Plan. Workshop V will build upon the efforts of the previous workshops to identify the long-term phasing of enhancement opportunities for Los Peñasquitos Lagoon. Beginning in October 2012, a series of workshops were held to solicit input from stakeholder groups and individual members of the community to assist in updating the Los Peñasquitos Lagoon Enhancement Plan and Program. Workshop participants reviewed, evaluated and refined the goals and objectives developed for the updated plan. Participants then developed enhancement strategies and components in light of opportunities and constraints that affect their implementation. What emerged from this stakeholder-driven process is a set of defined enhancement opportunities that, due to associated constraints, will require a phased approach to implementation.

The culmination of previous efforts, Workshop V will present a 50-year timeline for phased implementation of Lagoon enhancement opportunities developed by workshop participants. Opportunities that are more readily implemented will be considered for the primary phase of Lagoon enhancement followed by two sequential phases focused on opportunities that have greater constraints such as funding, coordination with infrastructure projects (e.g. double tracking of the railway) and the need for further study and design. We are grateful for participants' input on the past workshops and encourage your attendance in this critical final workshop so we can capture the community's input in the Enhancement Plan updates.
